

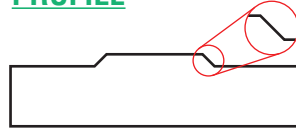
Embossing Die Styles

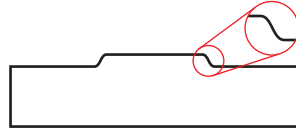

Emboss, Raised Flat w/Bevel



- Used for single-level embossing
- Beveled die edges create standard relief
- Used with thicker fonts and line art
- Chemically etched or CNC machined
- Least expensive embossing die style

Emboss, Raised Round



- Used for single-level embossing
- Rounded die edges create deeper relief
- Used with thinner fonts and line art
- Chemically etched or CNC machined
- More expensive than raised flat dies

Emboss, Multi-level



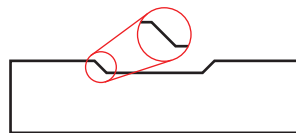
- Used for multi-level embossing
- Used for standard and deeper relief embossing
- Usually CNC machined
- More expensive than raised round dies

Emboss, Sculptured



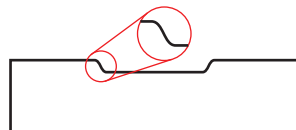
- Used for multi-level embossing
- Used for standard and deeper relief embossing
- Usually hand etched
- Most expensive embossing die style

Deboss, Flat w/Bevel



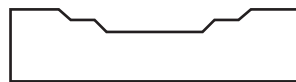
- Used for single-level debossing
- Beveled die edges create standard relief
- Used with thicker fonts and line art
- Chemically etched or CNC machined
- Least expensive debossing die style

Deboss, Round



- Used for single-level debossing
- Rounded die edges create deeper relief
- Used with thinner fonts and line art
- Chemically etched or CNC machined

- Usually CNC machined
- More expensive than raised round dies

- Most expensive debossing die style
